OFFICIAL PROGRAM

EVENT PERIOD

From Monday May 22, 2023 to Saturday May 27, 2023. The competition will take place on Friday 26 and Saturday 27 May 2023.

THE COURSE OF THE COMPETITION

Venue of the competition: The competition will take place on the large channeled Moselle.

- Width: about 70 meters
- Depth from 2 to 5 meters
- No to strong current depending on the passage of the barges.

FISH SPECIES

- Roach, bream, goby, bleak, carp and perch
- Pike and zander are not allowed

LIMITATIONS AND REGULATIONS

DISABLED

Groundbait quantity: 15 liters. Prepared groundbaits (wet and sieved) should be placed in graduated buckets. This quantity includes soil, gravel, seeds (corn, wheat, hemp, etc.) and other additives that are not toxic to wildlife and the aquatic environment.

Quantity of baits: 2 liters, including a maximum of 0.50 liters of jokers. A maximum quantity of 0.50 liters of earthworms is allowed in the total bait. Earthworms must be presented whole (not cut).

Bloodworms are for the hook only and must be presented in an "official FIPSed size" box. After control, the bloodworms intended for the hook can be used for baiting

VETERANS-MASTERS

Groundbait quantity: 20 litres. Prepared groundbaits (wet and sieved) should be placed in graduated buckets. This quantity includes soil, gravel, seeds (corn, wheat, hemp, etc.) and other additives that are not toxic to wildlife and the aquatic environment.

Quantity of baits: 2.5 liters including a maximum of 0.75 liter of jokers. A maximum quantity of 0.50 liters of earthworms is allowed in the total bait. Earthworms must be presented whole (not cut).

Bloodworms are for the hook only and must be presented in an "official FIPSed size" box. After the check, the bloodworms intended for the hook can be used for baiting.

The meshes of the basket must not exceed 10 mm by 10 mm. The keepnet must have a minimum diameter of 40 cm for the round ones, a minimum diagonal of 50 cm for the rectangular ones and a minimum length of 3.50 m.

The age limits for belonging to the "MASTERS" and "VETERANS" categories are as follows:

- MASTERS: be 55 years old on December 31 of the year preceding the championship.
- VETERANS: be 65 years old on December 31 of the year preceding the championship.

Athletes over 65, who therefore belong to the VETERANS category, can be part of the MASTERS category, the reverse not being possible.









In all cases, athletes over 75 on December 31 of the year preceding the championship must present a medical certificate attesting to their good state of health.

Competitors born between 1958 and 1967 inclusive will therefore be admitted to the MASTERS category, while those born between 1947 and 1957 inclusive will be able to participate in the VETERANS category.

SPECIAL POINTS OF THE COMPETITION COURSE

- FOR THE THREE CATEGORIES, THERE IS A SINGLE DIRECTION OF TRAFFIC FOR ALL VEHICLES.
- VEHICLES MUST BE PARKING ON THE OPPOSITE SIDE OF THE BANK AND THE TOW PATH MUST BE CLEAR AT ALL TIMES, EVEN DURING TRAINING AND COMPETITION (FOR EMERGENCY ACCESS)
- IT IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN TO TURN U-TURNS ON THE COURSE.
- THE SPEED IS LIMITED TO 15 KM/H.
- BIKES AND SCOOTERS ARE PROHIBITED ON THE TOW PATH.

Parking: a car park that can accommodate nearly 100 cars is available to visitors and accompanying persons.

SERVICES, EQUIPMENT

Meal:

A marquee and stands will be located at the entrance to the course. The AAPPMA of Toul will take care of the catering every day. Hot and cold dishes will be offered as well as drinks.










WHERE WE ARE AND HOW TO REACH US

REGISTRATIONS

Entries for the 15th World Angling Championship for Veterans, 5th World Angling Championship for Masters and 24th World Angling Championship for Disabled must be sent **before Friday, April 28, 2023**, using the attached registration forms. All additional information will be given to the teams during registration.

All teams must check in on **Monday May 22, 2023 between 7:30 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.** at the following location:

Address of the place where the teams score: 13 rue de Rigny 54 200 TOUL.

The committee will be present to provide you with further information on the event.

Each country must bring its national flags and a CD of its national anthem.

REGISTRATION FEES FOR DELEGATIONS

Masters and Veterans teams must pay the organizer a registration fee of € 1350.00.

Fees include:

- 8 tickets for the banquet (it will be possible to obtain additional tickets for € 60 each),
- 5 fishing permits for training,
- FIPSED fee € 150.00.

Disabled teams must pay the organizer a fee of € 1,200.00.

Fees include:

- 8 tickets for the banquet (it will be possible to obtain additional tickets for 60 € each),
- 5 fishing permits for training.

When registering for the championship, the Federations, in addition to the official members of the delegation, may also register additional people (Masters, Veterans and Disabled) who will be considered part of the delegation itself.

The Federations, in addition to the medals devoted to the official members of the Delegation, will be allowed to ask on place for extra medals (up to a maximum of 3 per team), upon payment of a contribution of € 25 per extra medal, which will also include the diploma. The fees for extra medals shall be paid to the organisers, who will then transfer the sum to F.I.P.S.e.d. In no case and for no reason extra medals in a number higher than that provided by these Rules may be requested from F.I.P.S.e.d.

ANTI-DOPING INFORMATION TUE REQUESTS



The athletes participating in the Championship, with the registration, implicitly accept all WADA anti-doping rules. Athlete whose illness or condition requires treatment with a prohibited substance or method must apply to CIPS for a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) following the CIPS strict TUE application process.

He/she shall then use the application form, which can be downloaded from the ITA website: https://ita.sport/uploads/2021/02/ITA_TUE_Form.pdf

The TUE request has to be sent to the following address: tue@ita.sport

Athletes must therefore consult the Prohibited List https://www.wada-ama.org/sites/default/files/2022-09/2023list en final 9 september 2022.pdf

If the TUE is granted, the athlete will then be permitted to use the medication during the period of validity of the TUE without committing an Anti-Doping Rules Violation (ADRV).

Regardless of whether a TUE has been granted or not, athletes should always declare on the doping control forms filled out during sample collection any medications and supplements taken within the seven days prior to sample collection, and any blood transfusions in the three months prior for blood samples.

If a TUE has already been granted by a NADO or by a RADO, the Athlete in question does not have to apply for any additional CIPS TUE, as CIPS recognizes all TUE granted by NADOs and RADOs.

COVID REGULATIONS

During any FIPSed championship scheduled in calendar, the COVID-19 regulations in force in the event hosting Nation are applied.

Any National delegation, teams, club, individual, are invited to inquire about any possible restrictions before leaving from their Country of origin.


